LOCAL RULES - BOMORE COURSE

We kindly ask you to:

Rake bunkers after use and place the rake in the centre of the bunker – repair pitchmarks – use a divot bag to repair divots – do not practice from the fairways onto the greens.

Local rules.

1. **Out of Bounds (rule 18.2)**

- a. Left of the white stakes on the 1st and 2nd hole.
- b. Left of the boundary fence on the 4th hole.
- c. Left of the red penalty area when playing the 5th hole as indicated by white stakes. There is no out of bounds when playing the 6th hole.
- d. Beyond the white stakes at the rear of the 7th green.
- e. Left of the white stakes on the 8th and 9th holes.

2. **Integral parts of the course:**

Bridges, stakes and wires of the boundary fence, all roads and paths.

3. **Movable Obstructions:** Stones in bunkers, rakes.

4. **Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16):**

Seats, shelters, distance markers, plastic grids, sleeper steps, timber and concrete edges to paths and roads, tee box markers, water points, the fence surrounding the 8th tee.

Fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference may be obtained under Rule 16.1. In addition where such an obstruction is on or within two club lengths of the putting green being played and is on the line between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: if the ball lies in the general area and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole (b) avoids such interference and (c) is in the general area but not on the putting green.

5. **Penalty Areas (Rule 17):**

Penalty areas are defined by red or yellow stakes or lines. Stakes or lines defining the margins of the penalty area are in the penalty area.

6. **Ground Under Repair:** all ground under repair is marked.

7. **Greenkeepers cuttings:** there are no greenkeepers cuttings piled for removal.
